TOURNAMENT RULES 2025

- 1. All anglers must check in at the welcome tent on arrival.
- 2. This is a catch and release tournament.
- 3. No live bait allowed, only artificial lures.
- 4. Tournament begins at 7:00 am at the Glenroy Preserve and last entry will be recorded by 11:00 am.
- 5. Entries must be measured and recorded by a tournament official.
- 6. Prizes will be awarded at the tournament by 12:00 pm. The committee reserves the right to end the tournament early, if necessary due to weather conditions.
- 7. Any disputes or issues will be resolved by the tournament committee and decisions are final and binding on all participants.
- 8. All entrants over 16 must have a valid fishing license and comply with all regulations of the state. For more information, please visit the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission at www.fishandboat.com
- 9. Participants under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 10. Participants must obey all posted rules and regulations at the Glenroy Preserve.
- 11. June 29th is our alternate date in case of inclement weather. If the event date is changed, all registered participants will be notified by phone/email a minimum of 12 hours prior to the event.
